Handwriting Intervention Strategies - MCEC

Emphasize quality of handwriting and not quantity Reduce the writing load Comments on the student's paper should emphasize the positive Motivate the student through incentives, positive reinforcement, and genuine enthusiasm Reversals should diminish in second grade and be infrequent in third grade
